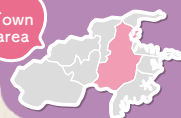


In this city, blessed with marine resources, people have always lived with the ocean. Enjoy a leisurely stroll in the sea breeze!

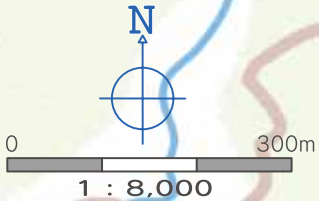

1 Kamiura Brewery of Ochi Shuzo (TBC)

This brewery was founded in 1885 and taken over by a local sake dealer for renovation, which is to be completed in January 2020. The facility is open to tourists.

2 Gyoran Falls

The Gyoran no Taki Fall is situated in a rare location, just 500 meters away from the sea, and listed as one of the 100 most beautiful views in Oita. In summer, the waterfall basin and downstream river serve as a refreshing swimming pool. <Rest areas available>



3 Takimihashira Shrine

Located at the foot of a waterfall, this shrine is noted in connection with Lord Takamasa Mori of the Saiki domain and known to have some 700 years of history dating back to the Kamakura era.

4 Azamui Station

Azamui Station on the JR Nippo Line is famous as the easternmost station in Kyushu.



5 Marinopolis Memorial Park & Bell of Happiness

Marinopolis Memorial Park was built in 1986 to celebrate the Marinopolis Plan of Oita Prefecture. There is also a "Bell of Happiness", which may bring happiness in your life if you ring it while looking out over the ocean. <Rest areas available>



6 Bungo Futamigaura

Bungo Futamigaura is listed as one of the 100 most beautiful views in Oita. The sacred straw festoon hung between a pair of rocks is one of the thickest festoons in Japan. It was also inscribed in the Guinness Book in 1994. The festoon is replaced on the second Sunday of every December. It is illuminated during the year-end and New Year holidays.
